



**Professor Aleksandër P. Xhuvani**

### **Member of the Albanian HERE**

Professor Aleksandër Xhuvani firstly graduated Electrical Engineer for Industry in 1980, at the Faculty of Engineering of Tirana University (Albania), then, in 1985, he graduated again Engineer on Industrial Electronics and DEA (**D**iplôme d'**E**tudes **A**pprofondies) in the field of Electrical Genius at ENSEEIHT (**E**cole **N**ationale **S**upérieure d'**E**lectrotechnique, d'**E**lectronique, d'**I**nformatique et d'**H**ydraulique de **T**oulouse) in France. Later on, in 1989, he obtained the scientific degree of "Doctor of National Polytechnic Institute of Toulouse" and, lately, in 2013 graduated Master's in Business Administration at the University Montesquieu-Bordeaux IV, in France.

Professor Xhuvani started his scientific career in September 1985 as researcher at LEEI (**L**aboratoire d'**E**lectrotechnique et d'**E**lectronique **I**ndustrielle) of ENSEEIHT. From November 1989 to January 1992 he assumed the position of lecturer at the Faculty of Engineering of Tirana University. From January 1992 to January 2008 he was appointed Director for International Relationships at the Polytechnic University of Tirana (UPT) and kept the position of full Professor at the Faculty of Electrical Engineering. Since January 2008, he keeps the position of full Professor at the Department of Computer Sciences near the Faculty of Information Technology of UPT. He was Member of the Albanian State Council for Higher Education and Science from 2007 until 2020; he is Member of the Albanian Academy of Arts and Sciences, he was Director of the French Institute of Administration of Tirana near the UPT from 1998 until 2018 and Member of the Accreditation Board from 2015 until 2021 and actually he is member of the Task Force of the Albanian Qualifications Framework.

Aleksandër Xhuvani is author or co-author of 30 scientific articles in the field of identification of parameter processes, database and computer engineering, 5 text books and written lessons, 2 main national projects, 20 international reports and statements. He is co-author of the white paper on national policy of higher education in 2014 and co-author of the 3 last law texts of higher education, of the law text of national qualification framework and of the code of good practice in scientific research. He has been invited professor at the University of Trieste, the University of Campobasso (Italy), ENSEEIHT and the University of Bordeaux (France), the University of Bristol (United Kingdom) and the University of Siegen (Germany).

In 2002 Aleksandër Xhuvani has been awarded the "Knight Medal of Academic Palms" by the French Minister of Education and, in 2014, the "Knight Medal of the National Order of Merit" by the President of the French Republic.
