

Marco Missaglia got his Ph.D in Economics at the University of Pavia (Italy), with a specialization in Development Macroeconomics. He is currently Associate Professor of International Macroeconomics at the University of Pavia, Italy. He spent 3 years (2012-2015) teaching Macroeconomics and Computable General Equilibrium Modeling in Colombia (Universidad Nacional de Colombia, Bogotá) and two years (2015-2017) as a professor of Advanced Macroeconomics in Ecuador (FLACSO, Facultad Latinoamericana de Ciencias Sociales, Quito). where he had the opportunity to strengthen his interests in the field of Macroeconomics for Development. His approach to macroeconomics belongs to the post-Keynesian tradition. His papers are published in journals like Metroeconomica, Economic System Research (Journal of Input-Output Association), Journal of Policy Modelling, Review of Political Economy, Economia Politica and others. He is vice-director of the Master Program in Cooperation and Development offered by the University of Pavia, the Italian pole of the Cooperation and Development Network (CDN), i.e. a network of twin programs in Colombia (Cartagena de Indias and Barranquilla), Palestine (Bethlehem), Kenya (Nairobi) and Nepal (Katmandu).
